

- Contact Lens Policy Disclosure

By state law, your contact lens prescription expires in 1 year and contact lenses cannot be purchased after that time period until there is a new contact lens examination.

Contact Lens Fitting/Evaluation Fee

Please note that some insurance plans (i.e. Horizon BCBG) *do not cover contact lens fitting/evaluation fee* to renew the contact lens prescription. Some vision plans require you to pay certain copays for contact lens fitting/evaluation. You are responsible for this portion of eye examination at the time of the visit. This is regardless of whether your contact lens prescription changed or not. All professional fees are nonrefundable.

Follow Up Care

To ensure well fitting contact lenses, comfort and good visual acuity, one or more follow up visits may be necessary. These follow up visits are of no additional charge as long as you return within 60 days after your initial exam. *After 60 days, you will be assessed a \$35 fee for a follow up care.* Failure to return for follow up care will also prevent ordering replacement lenses.

Contact Lens Training

All new contact lens wearers need to be trained to insert and remove the contact lenses on their own. Please be advised because of the safety issues, patients are required to practice removal and insertion of contact lenses in the office under the supervision of our staff. You may be asked to return at a later date for contact lens training if we do not have sufficient staff for training or you are not able to do so within reasonable time period.
